What: The OER STEM project will support up to 24 adult educators to identify, use, and evaluate science and math open educational resources (OERs) through a 6-month online user group.

Who: Current educators teaching mathematics and science for basic or below postsecondary adult learners. From October 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014, the User Group members will:

- Attend six webinars
- Identify and use math or science-specific OERs as part of their instruction
- Evaluate a minimum of four OERs using an online evaluation rubric
- Share high quality OERs, evaluations, and feedback online

Upon the completion of four OER evaluation reviews, each User Group member will receive a \$200 honorarium. Upon completion of five or more OER evaluation reviews, each User Group member will receive an additional \$100 honorarium.


