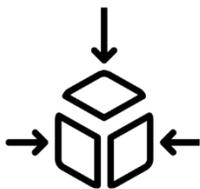


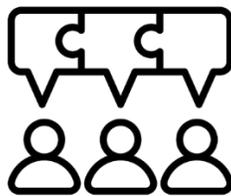


## Help Us Expand the IET Resource Repository!

Developed as part of the ADVANCE Integrated Education and Training (IET) initiative, the IET Resource Repository is a growing library of curriculum materials, planning tools, research and policy briefs, and other freely available materials arranged to support organizations in the design and implementation of IET programming. ## How Can You Contribute?

Throughout 2024 and early 2025, you can contribute to the repository by recommending exceptional IET-supporting resources developed by programs and practitioners. Priority for inclusion is given to resources specifically designed to support the design and implementation of IET.

## What Types of Resources Are Wanted?

Expansion of the repository is focused on resources specifically designed for IET that support organizations and practitioners in the design, implementation, evaluation, and improvement of their IET programming. Examples are presented in the table below.

## Know of or Have a Great Resource You Want to Share?

Before you submit a resource, consider the following requirements:

 **Freely Available**  
Resources must be free of charge and not require a license or subscription.

 **Publicly Housed**  
Resources must be hosted on a current, public-facing website that can be accessed via URL.

 **Permission to Share**  
Resources must be publicly shareable; open licenses are preferred but not required.

 **Openly Accessible**  
Resources must be available without requiring a password or a request for access.
